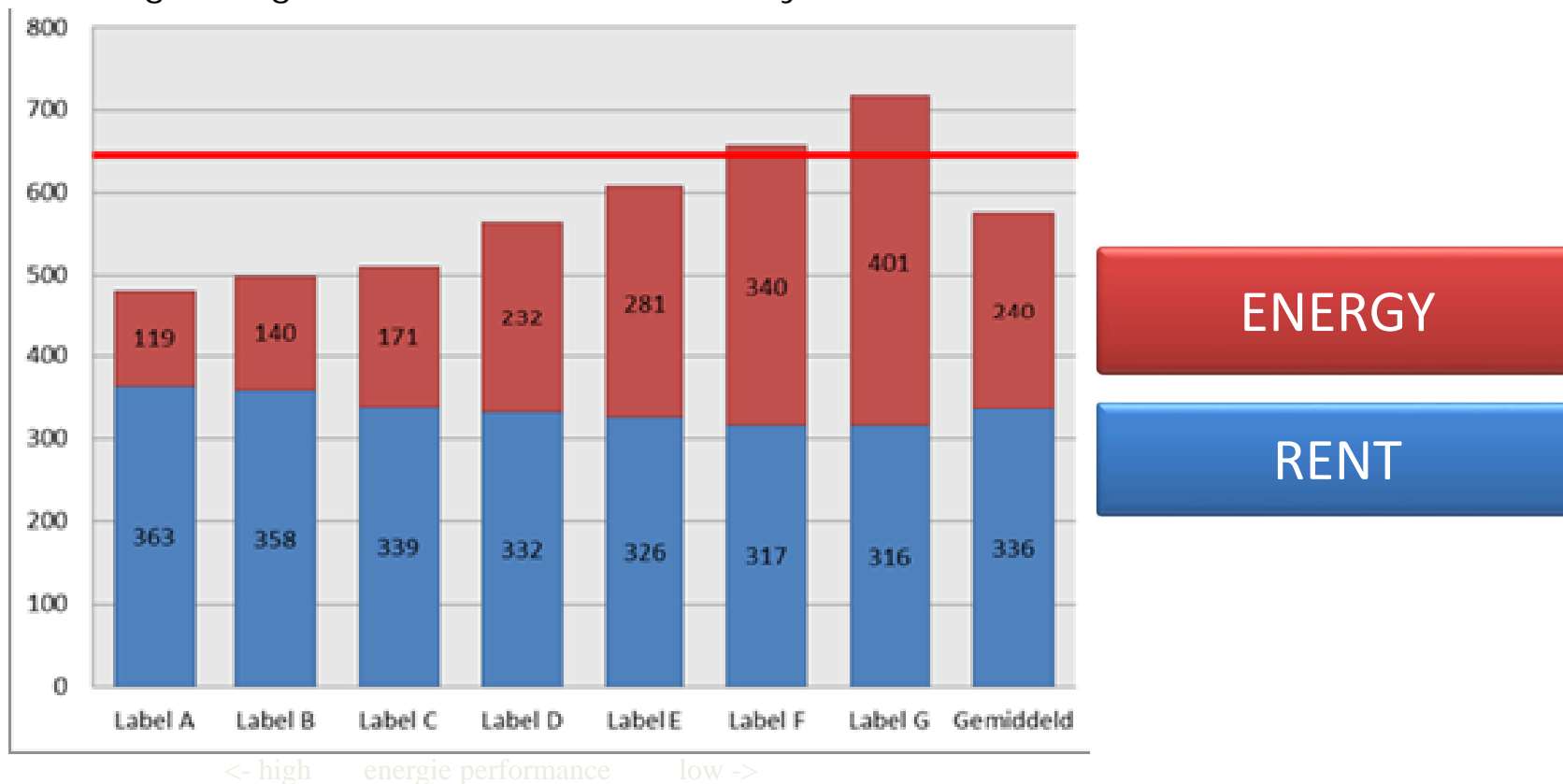

Living costs households in 2020

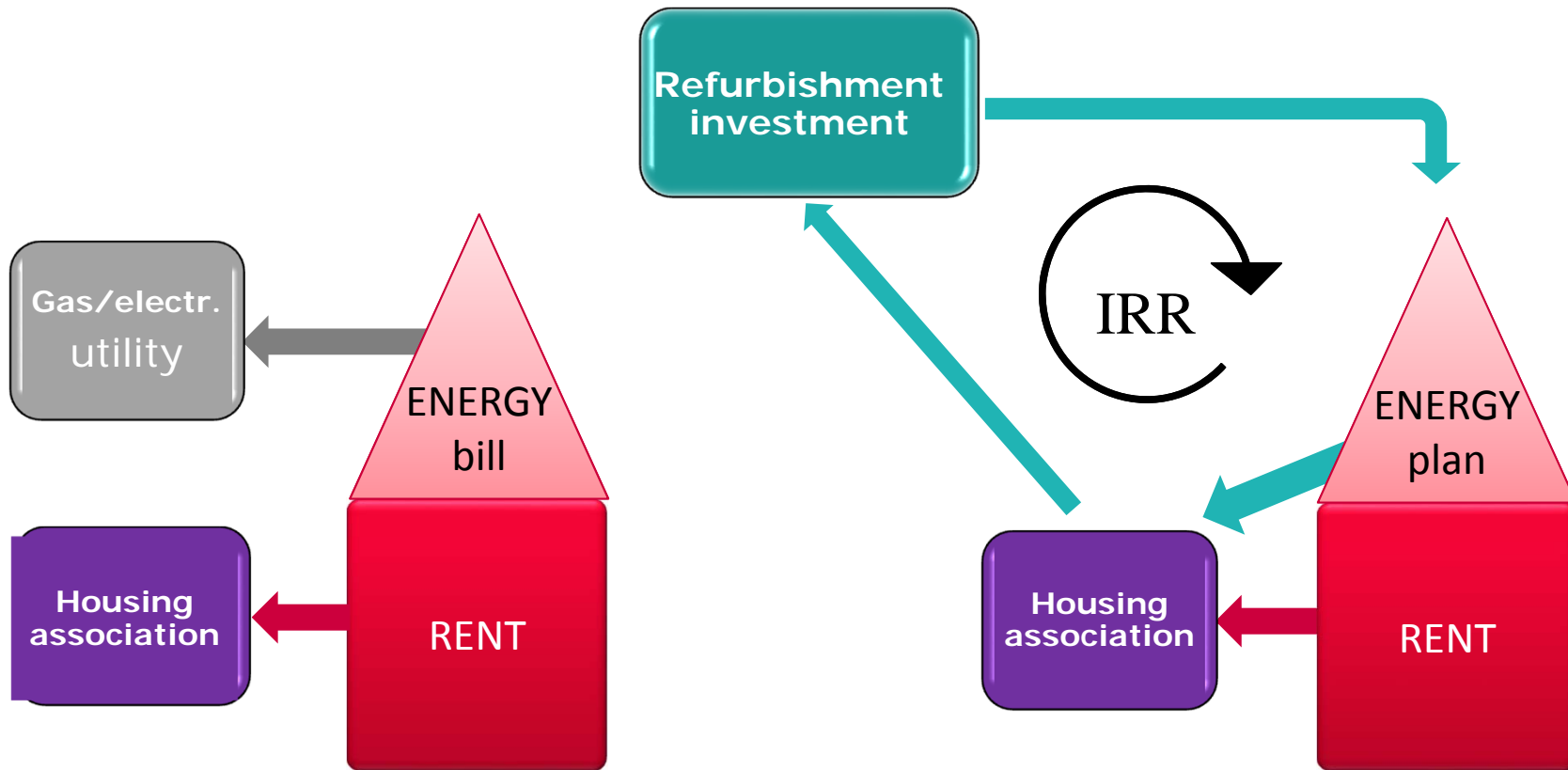
Average living costs of a low income family in 2020





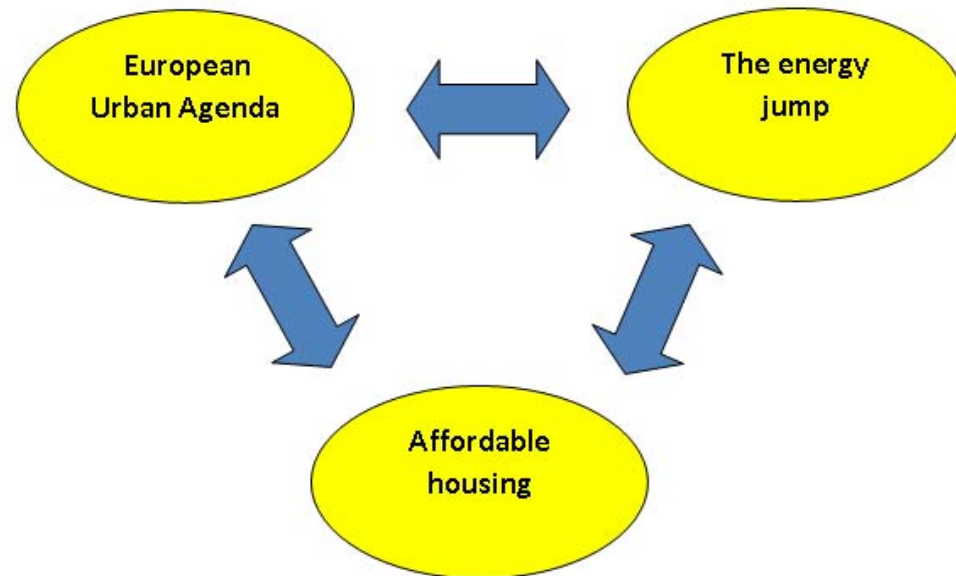
