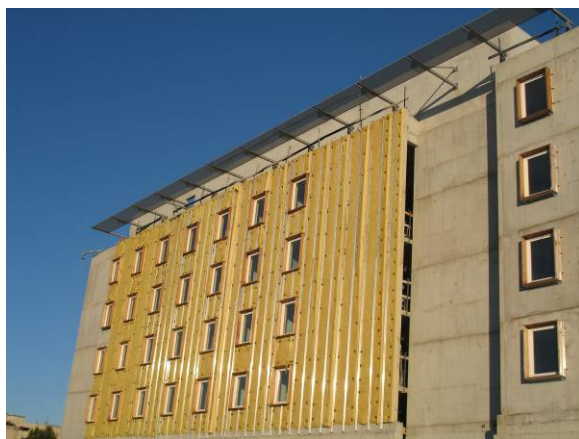


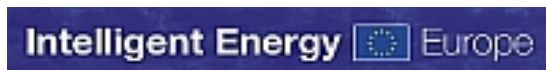

Actions carried out

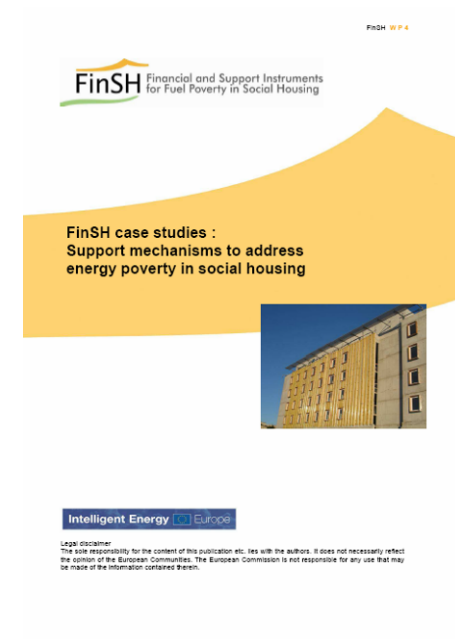
- Analysis of available financial products for energy efficiency renovations, production case studies;

- A set of common guidelines and production of a guidebook.
