





DEFINING AFFORDABLE HOUSING NEEDS IN THE EU

Eurostat definition of housing cost overburden: more than 40% of household income is spent on housing

- 8% of all Europeans and a third of those at risk of poverty spend more than 40% on housing
- 8% in material deprivation
- ☐ 17% have utility or rent/mortgage arrears
- 6% likely will have to leave their accommodation within 6 months
