From station to Congress Centre you can:

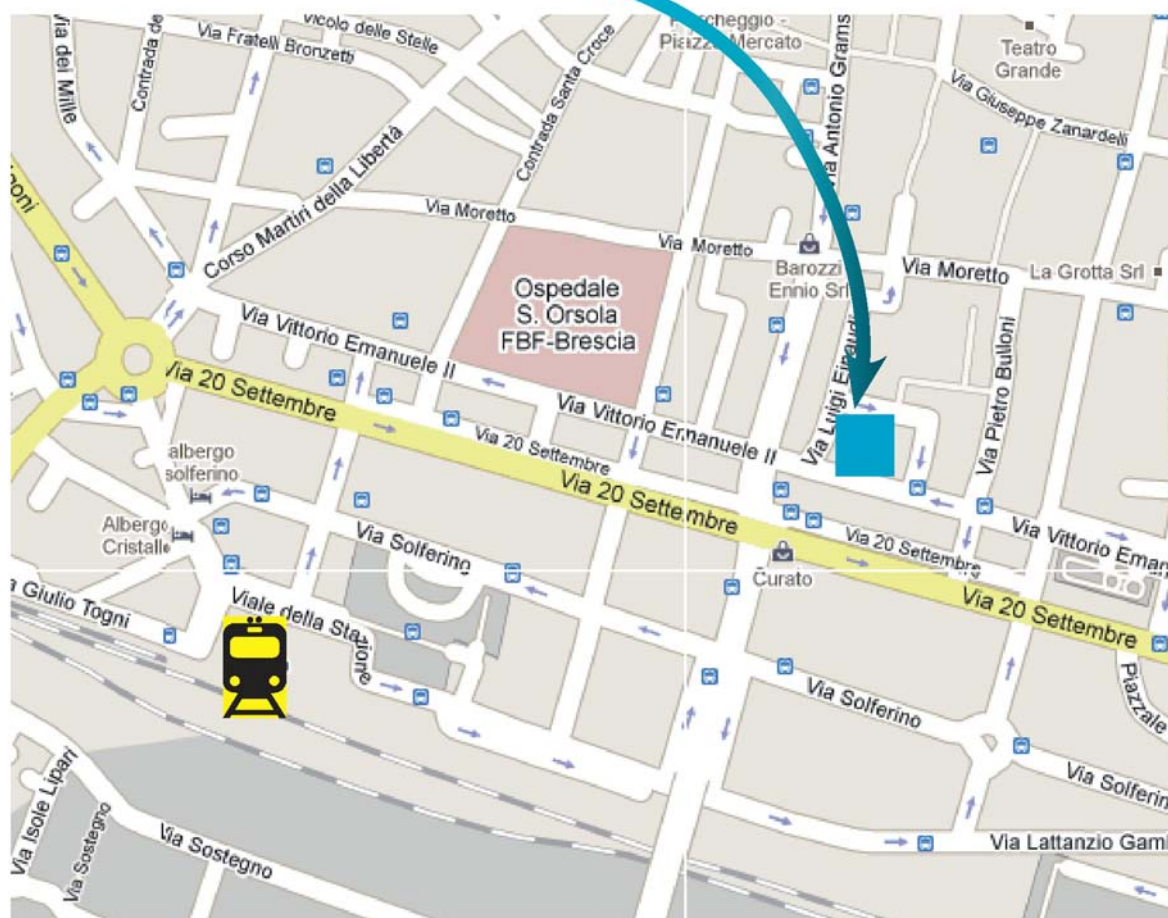
- take the taxi, just outside the station
